Bend Festival Task Force

Cascade Camera Club had a booth at the Bend Summer Festival the weekend of July 13-14. Huge thanks to Steve Peters for spearheading and organizing this effort. Thanks to all who helped at the booth and displayed their artwork. Sales for member artwork was modest as were sales of the book. We did sell 10 books which pretty much offset the cost of the event. More importantly, there seemed to be a lot of interest in the club. Many folks asked for more information about meetings. Some took the CCC business card and indicated they would come to a meeting. From a marketing perspective this seems like it was very successful. Hopefully we will gain some new members. Word on the street is that the Fall Festival is always a better time to sell product since folks are thinking about the holidays. Steve has some ideas about how to better promote the book next time.

Website Task Force:

Member Workshops:

Registration is now open for the Daneil Gregory Voice and Vision Workshop which will be held Oct 19-20th. The two days will include shooting in the field on Saturday and classroom instruction on Sunday. On Saturday there will be a morning shoot followed by a no host breakfast and mid-day break. The group will meet again in the evening for golden hour shots. Daniel is happy to stay late with anyone who is interested in night sky photography. The cost is \$400 per person for both days and includes snacks and lunch on Sunday. Daniel has agreed to stay for our Monday Oct 21 Program night. He will present "a fun black and white processing presentation with a few tips on printing". Membership Chair: Ruth Baker

Ruth has been asked by the board to keep track of attendance at meetings. This is an important metric for us as we determine the best meeting venues and the types of programing that is most interesting to the membership. Ideally, we would like to capture not just how many but also who attends our meetings. She will be trying a variety of methods of capturing this information. Please help by cooperating with these efforts.

Book Project Update

Our inventory of books is dwindling, which has caused the board to discuss the possibility of ordering a reprint. This is a decision that needs member input. Since we don't have sponsorship, we would be responsible for the entire up-front cost. The club currently has a balance of ~\$37,000. We generally have an operating budget that is covered by member dues but does not allow for extras like supporting speakers from outside Central Oregon. This is the estimate from PrintNinja for reprinting the book. We do get a discount for being a return customer and can make minor changes if needed.

At the \$60 retail price and rounding down to account for Collective Pallet fees (guestimate) we could net ~\$10,000 on 500 books, \$25,000 on 750 books and \$33,000 on 1000 books. Assuming all the books sell in a reasonable time frame. There are costs associated with storing books at Collective Pallet and for handling / fulfillment of orders. While we can afford to cover the costs, as a club we need to decide if we are willing to 'tie up' our funds and take the risk of books not selling. The board appreciates your input on this matter.
